

Aces Bring Long Win Streak Here Friday; All Schools In Action

Lower Merion High School, dangling an unbeaten string of 32 football games, moves into Norristown's Roosevelt Field this Friday night for the headline game of Montgomery County scholastic ranks.

The Ardmore Aces, whose spectacular feat began four years ago when they defeated Haverford High, 21-6, in a 1953 season opener, and the NHS Eagles, winners of three straight this season, will be meeting for the 43rd time in a series started in 1904.

Lower Merion holds a distinct edge, winning 26, losing 15, with two games ending in ties. The Main Liners have won the last ten after Norristown had won a 1945 thriller, 21-13. The Aces prevailed last year, 34-0.
