

Mike Branca, Guard, Elected Captain of 1958 NHS Eleven

Michael Branca, 5-foot-10 and 185 pounds of fulltime football player, has been elected captain of the 1958 Norristown High School football team.

Branca, who played brilliantly in the guard position for NHS in its undefeated and untied season this year, succeeds Robert Eastwood, tackle, as the Eagle leader.

Mike suffered injury in the semi-final game with Chester High and saw only limited duty in the Thanksgiving Day game with Upper Merion. But in that game he threw the key block which sent Willie Suber to one of his two touchdowns.

The NHS team will be honored Thursday evening, Dec. 12, with a testimonial dinner, sponsored by Central Montgomery Chamber of Commerce, for having established the first perfect season in 34 years.
