

# Norristown Bumps Trojans, Suber, Percy and Lee Lead Eagle Attack on Ground and In Air, Eagles Score Two on Pass Plays

Grooming their manners as a reception committee for Lower Merion High's long undefeated streak here next Friday night, Norristown High opened all the faucets last night and Roy Kent's charges bounced Pottstown High, 33-12, on the Trojan grid.

The Eagles scored in every period, settling for one each in the final two frames after romping to a 25-6 intermission advantage. Herebefore scoring only via the ground route, the third straight win was featured with a couple TD's by air.

The most exciting play of the night was one that never will get into the record books—an end zone interception by alert Stu Percy and a 100-yard runback, nullified by a clipping penalty.

But there were plenty of other moments for touchdown cheers.

Willie Suber, who went the long way twice against Phoenixville last week, scored on jaunts of 48 and 35 yards last night, and got in a 'shorty' from eight yards out. The 35-yarder was on a pass from Bob Lee.

Master craftsman Percy added two scores on a 1-yard nudge and a 12-yard pass from Bob Johnson. Lee got in the other tally on a 1-yarder. Gene Bishop booted two extra points to fill out the 38-point bulge.

Norristown registered scores the first two times it had the ball. Receiving the opening kickoff and putting the ball in play on their 36, the Kentmen got a 'shot in the arm' right off the bat when Lee scampered 51 yards to the Trojan 13. Four plays later Percy went over from the 1.

Pottstown got a first down after the next kickoff, but had to give up the ball when Capt. Bob Eastwood intercepted on the Trojan 39. Two pass plays, with Suber on the throwing end of one and Lee on the other, gobbled up yardage before Willie went over from the 8.

The Trojans went 35 yards for a second period score, cutting the margin to 13-6, a Krause to Ricketts pass scoring from two yards out.

But a 35-yard pass, Lee to Suber, got it back and sent the

count 19-6, and before the half ended Suber went 48 yards on a beautiful run,

Pottstown was first to score in the third quarter, Nagy running 59 yards for the longest tally of the night.

Lee, Suber and Percy romped for good gains as Norristown retaliated on a 69-yards on a nine-play drive, with Lee going over from the 1.

Scoring ended when Bob Johnson hit Percy on a 12-yard pass play early in the final period.
