Summer letter to football candidates for 1957 season,

Football candidates will receive their physical examinations Friday, August 16 at Roosevelt Field. Physical examinations will start at 10:00 A.M. The 32 boys that finished the 1956 season will be examined first.

Upon completion of physical examinations football equipment will be issued.

Monday, August 19 we open our 1957 campaign: All boys will report to Roosevelt Field in full battle gear at 9:00 A.M. Any boy that finished this week of practice will be taken to football camp the following week.

I base the success of past seasons on the first few weeks of double sessions. Any boy that will put out under the grueling sun in temperatures reaching close to 100 degrees is a boy who will come through when the game is really rough. If you're not willing to pay the price of sweat, blood, and bruises for victory think again before you show up for a suit August 16.

Ends, centers and specialty men are especially urged to practice skills during the summer months.

Remember that:

Summer is the time to have fun and enjoy yourself. Do what you and your parents want you to do with your summer vacation: A summer job is a restful change, even if hard physical work is entailed. Above all I want you to realize that this football coaching staff is making no demands upon your summer time.

#2 I will expect you to be in good physical shape by August 19, we plan to have a full game scrimmage with Plymouth-Whitemarsh August 31 and another with North Penn September 7.
