Norristown High Grid Hopefuls Get Physicals Friday, Aug. 16

Physical examinations and equipment issue for all candidates of Norristown High School's football team this year will take place next Friday afternoon, August 16, according to Head Coach Roy Kent.

Kent, starting his second year at the helm of the Eagle gridmen, said the physicals will start at 1 P. M., with the 32 players who finished last season receiving their exams first.

All aspirants for the eleven must have a physical before beginning drills at 9 A. M., Monday, Aug. 19, at Roosevelt Field, site of the physicals and equipment issue next Friday.

For the first time in more

than 10 years, the NHS football team will have a week's pre-season training at Camp Sun Mountain at Shawnee-on-Delaware. The practice there will be held from Monday, Aug. 26 until Saturday, Aug. 31. Approximately 60 boys will attend.

In addition to practicing at the camp, the candidates will be able to partake in all of the activities at the site, including boating, swimming, fishing and games.

Kent will be assisted this year by the same staff he had in 1956, namely Irv Hess, Leon Martz and Paul Zdano-wicz.
